Three Multigrain Pancakes are griddle-cooked to a fluffy golden brown and then topped off with real butter and served with 100% Pure Natural Syrup on the side.

Fresh blackberries and wild Maine blueberries in low-fat vanilla yogurt add a fresh twist to the popular Wholesome Mornin' Sampler. Topped with a honey-oat granola mix and almonds and served with a fresh baked blueberry-raspberry muffin, two farm-fresh Grade A eggs, prepared just the way you like 'em, and a choice of thick-sliced, hickory-smoked bacon, smoked sausage patties, or turkey sausage patties.

The new Six Grain n' Granola Pancake Breakfast blends honey oat granola mix and almonds into the batter then griddle-cooks it to a fluffy golden brown. Three pancakes are topped with real butter and served with Dickinson's Pure Honey and fresh sliced bananas.
